## PRIMARY COLLECTION CONTAINER PACKAGING FOR TRANSPORT **ACCEPTABLE WASTE LABELLING & STORAGE** Bag must be red with Anatomical waste, including: Tie bag securely and place Place labels on outside biohazard symbol. inside fibre drum. Tape drum of container. Do not cover ✓ Tissues printed symbols. lid closed. ✓ Organs and body parts (not including teeth, hair and nails) Position labels as shown below: Lid must be securely closed. Pail must be red with biohazard symbol. **Storage Room Temperature:** Refrigerate at 4°C or below immediately upon storage.

**Treatment/Disposal Method:** Anatomical waste is disposed of by incineration.
