## **LABELLING & STORAGE ACCEPTABLE WASTE** PRIMARY COLLECTION CONTAINER **PACKAGING FOR TRANSPORT** Bag must be red with Tie bag securely and place Place label on outside Anatomical waste, including: biohazard symbol. in cardboard box. Tape box of container. Do not cover ✓ Tissues flaps closed. printed symbols. ✓ Organs and body parts (not including teeth, hair and nails) Position label as shown below: Lid must be securely closed. Pail must be red with biohazard symbol. **Storage Room Temperature:** Refrigerate at 4°C or below immediately upon storage.

Treatment/Disposal Method: Anatomical waste is disposed of by incineration.
